ID Requirements ** ID needs to be <u>CURRENT</u> **

If an applicant is willing to use their Social Security Number on the application they do <u>NOT</u> need to bring any of the items listed below. If they want to identify themselves another way, they will need to have a <u>CURRENT</u> version of one of the items below to qualify for EBB:

- Driver's license
- Military ID
- Passport
- Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN)
- Government-issued ID
- Last utility bill
- Employment photo identification badge

Eligibility Documentation ** Documents need to be <u>CURRENT</u> **

Applicants only need to meet <u>ONE</u> of the criteria listed below to qualify for EBB. We suggest they bring/have available on their phone or device "paperwork" for as many ways as they qualify, just to have a back-up plan for the application. All documentation needs to be <u>CURRENT</u>.

- Medicaid
- SNAP
- Supplementary Security Income (SSI)
- Federal Public Housing Assistance
- Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit Programs
- Federal Pell Grant in current award year
- Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch Program or School breakfast program in the 2019-2020 or 2020-2021 school year
- Experienced substantial loss of income since February 29, 2020 (and the household had a total income in 2020 below \$99,000 for single filers and \$198,000 for joint filers)
 - Provide furlough or layoff notice and an application for or proof of receiving unemployment as well as tax docs for 2019 and 2020
- Meet the eligibility criteria or enrolled in a participating internet service provider's existing low-income or COVID-19 program.
